CHOOSING A COLLEGE







South Dakota is recognized as one of the most affordable states in the country to obtain a college degree, and is committed to providing accessible and affordable education to students.




Total Cost includes tuition and required fees plus room and board for the 2024 - 2025 academic year.

CONFIRM YOUR ENROLLMENT

Once you activate your *Fast Track Admission*, your preferred universities will contact you to address needs, answer questions, discuss finacial aid and scholarships, and verify your intention to enroll. Don't hesitate to reach out to the admissions office if you'd like to establish that contact sooner.

Once you choose to enroll in one of our universities, you will be assigned an advisor who will help you plan out one-, two-, and four-year goals to help keep you on track and ensure you are taking the correct coursework for your future plans.



- Activating your admission is different from enrolling. Make sure the university you've selected knows you will be joining them in the fall!
- *Fast Track Admission* is general admission. If you have a specific academic program in mind, talk to an admission counselor about any possible additional requirements.
- Keep up the excellent work. You've gotten this far in your academic journey, so keep going strong!





FALL

- Activate your *Fast Track Admission!* Select the school(s) you are interested on the Fast Track Activation Form. The information you provide will help you find the best fit for your future.
- Schedule campus visits to explore universities firsthand.
- Research and apply for scholarships, on the Statewide Scholarship Bulletin Board. Take note of priority deadlines for college-specific scholarships.
- Start the financial aid application process by creating your FSA ID on *StudentAid.gov* while you wait for the FAFSA to open on Dec. 1, or before.
- Consider taking high school dual credit courses in the spring semester to save time and money in college.

WINTER

- Complete the 2025-26 FAFSA as soon as it is available!
- Keep researching and applying for scholarships using the Scholarship Bulletin Board on *OurDakotaDreams.com.*

SPRING

- Commit to your university and request that your school sends final transcripts to the university you will attend.
- Figure out your university housing situation.
- Register to attend a new student orientation.
- Graduate and celebrate!
