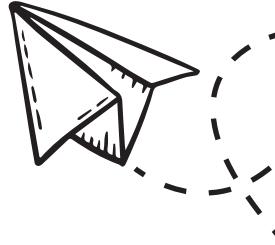
FASTTRACK ADMISSION

YOU ARE IN! TAKE THE FAST TRACK TO COLLEGE IN SOUTH DAKOTA

Fast Track Admission is a pilot program that allows high school seniors to skip the traditional college application process for participating universities based on their academic achievements. In late September, eligible students will receive notifications regarding which universities are offering Fast Track Admission. To activate their admission, students must complete the Fast Track Activation Form linked in the September notification.

- On track to graduate high school in Spring 2025 with a regular high school diploma
- 2.0 or higher GPA

- Make your final decision. Activating your Fast Track Admission is different from enrolling. Make sure the university you've decided to attend knows you will be joining them in the fall.

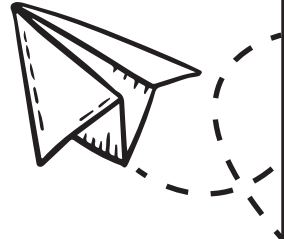
