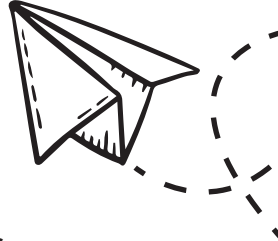
FASTTRACK ADMISSION

YOU ARE IN! TAKE THE FAST TRACK TO COLLEGE IN SOUTH DAKOTA

Fast Track Admission is a pilot program that allows high school students to skip the traditional college application process for participating universities based on their academic achievements. In April, eligible students will receive notifications regarding which universities are offering Fast Track Admission. To activate their admission, students must select their schools of interest using the link in their letter of within their High School Dual Credit registration form.

- 2.0 or higher GPA

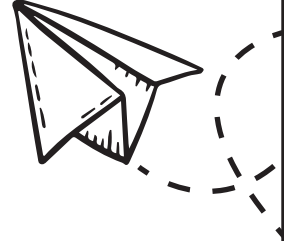
